SAHSSI invites non-professional emerging Aboriginal artists aged 14 years and over who currently reside in the Illawarra and Shoalhaven regions of NSW to submit artworks for our Aboriginal Art competition.

SAHSSI is seeking artwork that will:

- provide main theme design for our Reconciliation Action Plan (a document that will be published and displayed on the internet)
- provide Aboriginal marketing material for our website and brochures or other corporate documents such as our Annual General Meeting report(s),
- provide Aboriginal posters at our sites such as at our women’s refuges
- be featured prominently at our Head Office with the background story and artist information (original artwork)

The artwork should reflect the values and purpose of our organisation which are:

4. **The image of your artwork sent must be good quality and please make sure you keep an original of your artwork because we will need it if you win. We may also request originals to assist with the final judging process - original artwork must be no smaller than 310mm x 440mm (portrait or landscape accepted).**

2019 SAHSSI ABORIGINAL ART COMPETITION

Terms & Conditions

1. Information on how to enter the “2019 SAHSSI Aboriginal Art Competition” (**Competition**) and prizes form part of these terms and conditions of entry (**Terms and Conditions**).
2. By completing and signing the form for entry in to the Competition (the **Entry Form**), you (the **Entrant**) agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions. The Entrant warrants and represents that the Entrant has full power, capacity and authority to accept these Terms and Conditions.
3. The promoter of the Competition is Supported Accommodation and Homelessness Services Shoalhaven Illawarra (SAHSSI) Incorporated ABN 85 784 780 738 of 63a Market St, Wollongong NSW 2500 (**SAHSSI**).
4. The competition commences at 9:00am on 11th April 2019 and closes 5:00pm on 21 June 2019 (Competition Period). Any entry received after the Competition Period will be ineligible.

Entry to the Competition

5. Entrants must:
 - a. currently reside in the Illawarra or Shoalhaven region;
 - b. be of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent;
 - c. identify as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander;
 - d. be accepted as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander by an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander community; and
 - e. be aged 14 years or older at the time the Entry Form is submitted.
6. SAHSSI employees are not eligible to enter the Competition.
7. In order to enter the Competition, the Entrant must make a valid entry per clause 8 below (**Entry**).
8. To make a valid Entry, the Entrant must:
 - a. create an **original** art work that is capable of being visually reproduced (the Artwork);
 - b. not previously have received an Award for this Artwork;
 - c. submit a photograph no larger than 15MB in .jpg or .png format of the original Artwork to SAHSSI, together with a completed Entry Form (Entry form available at www.sahssi.org.au);
9. The Artwork must be the property of the artist. Proof of ownership may be requested.
10. The Entrant may submit the Entry in one of the ways detailed below:
 - a. **Email:** Send a completed and signed entry form and an image no larger than 15MB in .jpg or .png format of the Artwork via e-mail to jacqui@sahssi.org.au and gianna@sahssi.org.au
 - b. **Post:** Post a completed and signed entry form and an image of the Artwork to:

 - c. **Drop-off:** Attend Level 1, 63a Market St Wollongong in person and hand in a completed and signed Entry Form and original Artwork between 9am and 5pm, Monday to Friday. NOTE: If

you are in the Shoalhaven and can't post or email contact Jacqui or Gianna 02 4229 8523 and we can arrange a drop off point for Shoalhaven.

11. Each Entrant:
 - a. is to submit an entry form (collaborative artworks are acceptable however each contributing artist is to submit an entry form), and
 - b. can enter a maximum of one individual entry plus one collaborative entry.
12. Submitted photographic Entries of the Artwork must be in jpeg, png format.
13. The original Artwork retained by the Entrant must not be framed or mounted behind glass and must be at least 310mm x 440mm (portrait or landscape accepted).
14. SAHSSI reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process.
15. SAHSSI will not accept responsibility for late entries, partial or garbled computer transitions, damage to or loss of the Entry or any original Artwork due to postage or handling, or for technical failures of any kind, including but not limited to electronic malfunction or damage to any network, hardware or software.
16. Entries that are forged, incomplete, illegible or that do not comply with the Terms and Conditions will be deemed invalid.

Artwork Warranties, Moral Rights, Cultural Consent and Ownership

17. By entering this Competition and signing the Entry Form, the Entrant warrants that:
 - a. the Artwork is the Entrant's own original work;
 - b. the Artwork does not breach any Australian or international copyright laws;
 - c. the Entrant is entitled to grant SAHSSI all rights, title and ownership with respect to the Artwork;
 - d. aside from these Terms and Conditions, the Entrant has not entered into any deed, contract, arrangement or understanding with any person dealing in any way with the Artwork;
 - e. the Artwork has not been registered as a trademark, or is the subject of any application for trademark status, nor has the Artwork been registered in any way with respect to any identifiable intellectual property rights;
 - f. at the time of submission of the Artwork, there is no cultural or religious reason or any other impediment that prevents the Artwork from being used, exhibited, published or reproduced by SAHSSI;
 - g. the Artwork does not incorporate elements derived from Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander heritage without the informed consent of the traditional owners; and
 - h. the use of the Artwork by SAHSSI will not infringe the rights of any third parties.
18. By entering this Competition and signing the Entry Form, the Entrant agrees that, should the Entrant win the Competition, they:
 - a. assign the right, title and ownership of the Artwork and any Intellectual Property Rights (meaning copyright, future copyright, and any other registrable rights that may have vested or will vest in the Entrant) that the Artwork may contain to SAHSSI; and
 - b. provide consent in favour of SAHSSI and its authorised licensees or assignees, to use the Artwork in any way or for any purpose that may infringe upon the Entrant's Moral Rights, as defined in Chapter IX of the *Copyright Act 1988 (Cth)*, except of the Entrant's right not have the Artwork falsely attributed to another individual or company.
19. The Entrant agrees that they will do all things necessary, including signing any deed or document necessary to give effect to the provisions of clause 18 of these Terms and Conditions.
20. Should the winner of the Competition (the '**Winner**') refuse to comply with clause 18 or 19 of these Terms and Conditions, then that Entrant waives all right to receive the Prize and a new Winner will be determined.
21. SAHSSI will use its best endeavours to ensure that:

- a. its use, duplication or reproduction of the winning Artwork is only for the purposes of SAHSSI marketing, publicity, advertising, branding and other related SAHSSI purposes, whether online in any context or in print;
 - b. where the Artwork is reproduced, published or communicated by SAHSSI, the Winner will be acknowledged as the creator of the Artwork in an appropriate form where practical to do so; and
 - c. without limiting the rights granted to SAHSSI, the Artwork is not subject to any material alteration or distortion that is prejudicial to the Artwork of the Winner.
22. The Entrant agrees to indemnify and keep indemnified SAHSSI against all claims, demands, losses and damages that SAHSSI incurs as a result of breach of any warranties given by Entrant under these Terms and Conditions.

The Prize

23. The Entrant with the winning Entry (Winner) will receive \$2,000.00 cash (Prize).

Selecting the Winner

24. There will be only one Winner.
25. The Winner will be selected based on the following criteria with respect to the Artwork submitted by the Winner:
- a. aesthetic quality;
 - b. creative originality;
 - c. representation of SAHSSI vision, purpose and values
 - d. compliance with Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander customary rights and law; and
 - e. any other aspect the judges consider important with respect to the Artwork.
26. The winning Entry will be selected by an official Committee made up of:
- a. an Aboriginal Community representative from the Shoalhaven;
 - b. an Aboriginal Community representative from the Illawarra;
 - c. Committee Member, SAHSSI;
 - d. CEO, SAHSSI; and
 - e. a SAHSSI Aboriginal employee representative.
27. The Entrant acknowledges that their Artwork may be copied or reproduced for the purposes of judging the Competition.
28. An Entrant may be required to supply the original Artwork at their own expense and risk to allow the Committee to make its final decision.
29. The Committee's decision is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.

Notification of Winner and Claiming the Prize

30. The Winner will be notified by telephone or by email (the '**Confirmation Email**') within 2 weeks of the end of the Competition Period.
31. In order to claim the Prize, the winner will be required to supply the original Artwork to SAHSSI and complete and sign an Intellectual Property Deed Poll that assigns all right and title of the Artwork to SAHSSI.
32. Should the Winner fail or refuse to:
- comply with the requirements in clause 31
- SAHSSI reserves the right to select a new Winner.
33. SAHSSI reserves the right to request proof of identity from the Winner prior to providing the Winner with the Prize.

Unclaimed Prize

34. If the Prize is unclaimed by a Winner for 2 weeks after the date of sending the Confirmation Email, or SAHSSI is unable to contact the Winner after making all reasonable attempts to do so in that period, then SAHSSI reserves the right to select a new Competition winner.

No Liability for SAHSSI

35. SAHSSI and its controlled entities accept no responsibility for lost, late, stolen, damaged or misdirected Entries.
36. If, for any reason, the Competition is not capable of running as planned, SAHSSI reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition, subject to any directions (if any) from any regulatory authority.
37. Except to the extent that any such liability cannot be excluded by law, SAHSSI is not liable for any loss, damage or injury of any nature whatsoever (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) which is suffered or sustained as a result of or in connection with this Competition or arising from a Winner's acceptance, use or misuse of the Prize. For abundant clarity, no responsibility is assumed for: any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to, or alteration of, Entries; or problems or technical malfunctions of any telephone network or lines, computer online systems, services, or providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any email or electronic entry to be received on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any web site, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to the Entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participation in or downloading any materials for this Competition.
38. Any costs associated with accessing, entering, or otherwise taking part in the Competition are the responsibility of the Entrant.
39. All decisions of SAHSSI with respect to the matter referred to in these Terms and Conditions are final and no correspondence will be entered into, including in the event of a dispute.

Use of Personal Information

40. SAHSSI is committed to protecting the privacy of Entrants.
41. By entering this Competition, Entrants agree to SAHSSI using and disclosing the Entrant's personal information to the extent required to conduct the Competition, verify the Entries, identify the Winner and issue the Prize.
42. Subject to clause 41, SAHSSI reserves the right to request permission, at the time of the Winner accepting the Prize or by contacting the Winner by telephone or email, to use the Winner's name, likeness, image and/or voice (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media or marketing material for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting SAHSSI and this competition.
